



Albania has many energy storage projects

Why does Albania need to import energy?

Changing weather patterns over the years have forced the country to import energy to cover domestic needs, as a lack of storage capacity requires Albania to sell its generated power during peak months of production.

What is the total capacity of the solar projects in Albania?

There are currently at least 13 solar projects in the pipeline with a capacity of 1.24 GW between them. In addition, a recent wind farm proposal has been given strategic investment status in the country. But besides from controversial gas from controversial countries, Albania is also looking at wind and solar power.

What are the opportunities for solar energy deployment in Albania?

Opportunities for the deployment of solar energy are extensive. Albania's solar insolation is very high throughout most of its territory at more than 1 500 kWh/m² annually, with peaks of 1 753 kWh/m² annually, particularly in the western part of the country.

What is Albania's energy sector strategy?

In 2018, Albania adopted its National Energy Sector Strategy, which examined various energy development scenarios and set forth a series of key indicators and objectives that will shape Albanian's energy sector over the period from 2018 to 2030 (Table 2). Most notably, the strategy stipulated a 42% share of renewable energy in the TPES by 2030.

Will Excelerate Energy Supply a floating power plant to Albania?

U.S. liquefied natural gas company Excelerate Energy Inc. will supply floating power plants to Albania, hoping that the deal will get the company access to Europe's natural gas market. Excelerate will provide power barges that will generate electricity and buoy the grid in the southeastern European nation.

In addition to eliminating the electricity deficit and taking electrification to new sectors, Albania can increase its potential to unlock new industries and investment using clean energy. The country can explore opportunities to produce green hydrogen through solar and wind power.
