Are US solar panels harmed by cheap imports from Southeast Asia?

The U.S. International Trade Commission (USITC) has ruled that U.S.-based solar panel makers have been significantly harmed by a flood of cheap imports from four Southeast Asian nations, removing the final obstacle to the imposition of significant tariffs on these goods.

Most solar panels installed in the US are currently made abroad, and around 80% of those imported solar panels are made in Malaysia, Vietnam, Thailand, and Cambodia.

Is China dumping solar products below cost via Southeast Asian proxies?

A final decision from the US International Trade Commission is expected in June. The case, brought by US and South Korean solar manufacturers including Hanwha Qcells and First Solar, alleges that Chinese producers, benefiting from state subsidies, are dumping products below cost via Southeast Asian proxies.
