WASHINGTON, Sept 9 (Reuters) - The U.S. Federal Aviation Administration issued a safety alert on Tuesday to airlines over risks from lithium batteries in aircraft passenger compartments, citing a large number of serious incidents.

Are lithium-ion batteries a fire hazard?

The Federal Aviation Administration issued a safety alert about the fire risk of lithium-ion batteries on planes. Lithium batteries in overhead bins or carry-on bags can be hard to monitor, potentially delaying fire detection. The FAA recommends airlines review their firefighting procedures and passenger safety messaging.
