What type of power plugs are used in the Cook Islands?

On the Cook Islands, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type I are used. The standard voltage is 240 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. For more information, select the country you live in at the top of this page. We don't sell power plug adapters. We refer you to Amazon, where you will find a great selection of travel adapters.

What type of power sockets are on the Cook Islands?

The power sockets on the Cook Islands are of type I. The standard voltage is 240 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. Check your need for a power plug (travel) adapter on the Cook Islands.

Do I need a power adapter in Cook Islands?

If your devices are compatible with these specifications, you will not need a power adapter. However, if your devices use a different plug type or are not compatible with the voltage in Cook Islands, you will need a power adapter and/or a voltage converter/transformer.

What voltage does Cook Islands use?

The voltage in Cook Islands is the same as in Europe. However, Europeans will need a travel adapter when traveling to Cook Islands. What Outlet does Cook Islands Use? Type I plug sockets are used in Australia, New Zealand. They have two flat pins and a grounding pin. These plugs are typically used with devices that have a voltage of 230V.

Can a universal power adapter fit a Cook Islands outlet?

Universal power adapters usually come with multiple plug types and can be adjusted to fit Cook Islands outlets and many others. If your devices are not compatible with the voltage in your destination country, a voltage converter or transformer will also be necessary to convert the voltage to the appropriate range for your devices.

Do Cook Islands have electrical outlets?

No, the electrical outlets in Cook Islands are different from those in the United States. In Cook Islands electrical outlets of type I are used, while the United States has electrical outlets of types A & B. Do I need a travel adapter for Cook Islands? The electrical outlets and power plugs in Cook Islands are of type I (see images).

Power adapter for Cook Islands needed? Since you'll need a travel adapter for Cook Islands when coming from USA, we suggest opting for a universal power adapter that works in many ...

Which power outlets are used in Cook Islands? The Cook Islands utilize a standard voltage of 240 volts and a frequency of 50 Hz. The country primarily uses plug type I, which is a three-pin ...
