

Does India have a power sector?

However, India's electricity and energy sector is listed in the concurrent list of seventh schedule of the Constitution of India, which primarily means that both the Central and State Governments have jurisdiction of the sector.

How is India generating electricity?

India has recorded rapid growth in electricity generation since 1985, increasing from 179 TW-hr in 1985 to 1,057 TW-hr in 2012. The majority of the increase came from coal-fired plants and non-conventional renewable energy sources (RES), with the contribution from natural gas, oil, and hydro plants decreasing in 2012-2017.
