



Is outdoor power supply flammable

Is it safe to use electrical equipment outside?

When using electrical equipment or working near power lines outdoors, weather conditions and the presence of utility equipment present safety risks that are not typically found indoors. Therefore, it's important to operate equipment properly and be aware of potential hazards around you.

Is gas flammable?

Gasoline is extremely flammable and explosive. Always keep your generator as far as possible from any open flames or objects that can generate heat. Fuel vapors can travel long distances to flammable sources. In addition, avoid overfilling the fuel tank: Fuel overflow can cause a hot engine to catch fire or explode.

What should you not do if you are a fire hazard?

Never use a power tool around flammable liquids such as gasoline or solvents. Keep the work area clean of sawdust, shavings or anything else that could pose a fire hazard. When using outdoor electrical appliances such as hedge trimmers or edgers, wear sturdy, rubber-soled shoes or boots. Never go barefoot.

Are weed trimmers flammable?

Such as, but not limited to, lawn mowers and weed trimmers may contain hazardous materials in the form of fuels and/or batteries. Including Cigarette Lighters or Lighter Refills or Torches may contain flammable gas or flammable liquid. May include adhesives, paints, sealants, solvents or other chemicals and gases.

Can a non-spillable battery be shipped as non-hazardous?

Tested, proven non-spillable batteries are allowed to be shipped as non-hazardous within the U.S. Batteries and packaging must be marked "NONSPILLABLE" or "NONSPILLABLE BATTERY". Both rechargeable and non-rechargeable power sources, common in computers, cell phones, cameras and other small electronic devices.
