

# Mozambique Telecom Base Station Cost Price

How much does a mobile phone contract cost in Mozambique?

Every year, the International Telecommunication Union calculates for many countries what a mobile phone contract costs to use. A monthly budget averaging US\$7.50 was calculated for Mozambique in 2023. Compared to the previous year, this amount has fallen by 6 percent.

What telecommunications are available in Mozambique?

Telecommunications in Mozambique include radio, television, fixed and mobile telephones, and the Internet. AM 13, FM 17, shortwave 11 (2001). Television stations: 1 state-run TV station supplemented by private TV station; Portuguese state TV's African service, RTP Africa, and Brazilian-owned TV Miramar are available (2007).

How much does Mozambique cost a month?

A monthly budget averaging US\$7.50 was calculated for Mozambique in 2023. Compared to the previous year, this amount has fallen by 6 percent. The ITU refers to the costs for monthly use and includes 140 telephony minutes, 70 text messages and a data transfer of 2 GBytes.

Why is Mozambique launching a telecom reform?

Mozambique was one of the first countries in the region to embark upon telecom reform and to open the sector to competition. The mobile segment in particular has shown strong growth since the launch of services by Vodacom Mozambique to compete against mCel, the then mobile subsidiary of the national telco Telecommunicações de Moçambique.

What is happening in Mozambique Telecom?

Mozambique Telecom progresses with the second phase of its network modernisation program. Raxio Group completes its Tier-III carrier-neutral colocation data centre in Maputo. Telecom regulator implements revised SIM card and mobile device registration scheme to tackle fraud. Starlink launches satellite broadband services in Mozambique.

How many people in Mozambique have a broadband connection?

Values above 100 percent mean that, on average, every inhabitant has more than one connection. Mozambique is lagging behind in the expansion of broadband internet connections. Around 21 percent of all residents have access to the internet.

Mozambique is well-served by international connectivity and, in general, there do not appear to be any concerns regarding the pricing or availability of international connectivity. However, it can ...
