For portable power stations, capacity is measured in watt-hours (Wh), telling you how much energy the unit stores. Weekend adventures typically need 200-300Wh for smartphone charging and LED lighting. Glamping and campground camping with amenities require 500-700Wh units to power fans, portable coolers, and CPAP machines.

Should you buy a power brick or a portable power station?

Small power bricks have enough juice to charge your phone a few times, while a cooler-sized portable power station can keep vital electronics running during a power outage or camping trip, and the most powerful options will provide electricity to your entire house.

What is the best portable power station for water resistance?

Best portable power station for water resistance It might not be a true rugged power station, but the Bluetti AC240P boasts IP65 rating to protect it against water and dust ingress. Key specs are 1843Wh capacity and a 2400W output.
