

Replace battery and reset BMS

How do I Reset my BMS?

Resetting the BMS usually involves the steps below. Disconnect any chargers or power sources to ensure nothing is actively charging the battery. Remove the battery from the vehicle and let it settle for thirty minutes to an hour to dissipate residual electricity. Press and hold the reset button on your battery to reboot the battery and the BMS.

When is a BMS reset necessary?

Resetting the BMS is only necessary when the system malfunctions or the battery isn't performing as usual. Resetting the BMS restores the system to its default settings, allowing it to make adjustments to battery performance according to the vehicle. The reset helps extend a car battery's lifespan by ensuring efficient power use.

How do I Reset my battery management system (BMS)?

Next, locate the BMS reset button or switch on the battery management system. Press and hold this button for 10-15 seconds. If your lithium battery doesn't have a reset button, you can still reset the BMS by discharging it completely and then charging it back up again. This process will help to recalibrate the BMS and restore its functionality.

How do I Reset my lithium battery BMS?

Resetting a Lithium Battery BMS might sound like a daunting task, but it is actually quite simple. The first step is to disconnect the battery from any power source and remove it from its housing. Next, locate the BMS reset button or switch on the battery management system. Press and hold this button for 10-15 seconds.

Do non electric vehicles need a BMS reset?

Non-electric vehicles don't have complex battery management systems like those used on electric vehicles. However, newer non-EVs do have a basic system to manage the battery, so on a non-EV, a BMS reset might be necessary after a 12-volt battery replacement or a system malfunction.

Should a BMS reset be performed with a new battery?

If the BMS reset is not immediately performed with a new battery, the BMS will continue to protect thinking the old battery is installed. I want to end by saying, Ford requires the dealer to perform a BMS reset as we pay for the replacement cost and warranty that work.

On newer Ford vehicles with BMS, you can reset the system after you've changed the battery or it's giving you issues by flashing the high beam 5 times, then press and release the brake pedal 5 ...

Access the battery module (Battery ECU) and select options such as reset battery history, clear DTCs, or re-initialize BMS. Follow the on-screen instructions and wait for the ...
