

Does Senegal have a telecommunications sector?

The Government of Senegal is developing the Information and Communications Technology (ICT) sector as a national initiative. Since liberalization of the sector in the 1990s, the country has transformed into a leader in West Africa for developed and modern telecommunications infrastructure. The country ranks 14th in Africa for Network Readiness.

Does Senegal have a 4G network?

Sonatel the historic public operator of telecommunications in Senegal currently works under the brand, Orange, a French-based company. Orange has launched 4G and 4G+, while Free obtained its 4G License in 2018. Cable Services - In 2017, Senegal's bandwidth was 23 Gigabytes/second (Gb/s).

Why do people use prepaid mobile services in Senegal?

Most consumers in Senegal use prepaid mobile services in contrast to contract-based services. Competition amongst mobile service providers has lowered the prices per user. Market consumers also mainly rely on smartphone services for internet access, which decreases demand for fixed home connections.

Is Senegal a network ready country?

The country ranks 14th in Africa for Network Readiness. In 2016, the Government of Senegal took steps to advance the sector by adopting the National Digital Economy Strategy 2025, which aims to make the country a hub for digital transformation in the region and beyond.

Does Senegal have a 5G network?

Senegal is experiencing increased availability of 3G/4G fiber optic services in the country, and limited 5G testing in Dakar. According to telecom regulatory agency ARTP, the internet penetration rate was 68 percent in 2019.
