What devices do EMS use?

Why is radio communication important in EMS?

Proper radio communication allows EMS personnel to prepare for the call before arrival on the scene. How do EMS responders communicate with patients?

The number one rule of therapeutic communication is remaining calm while reassuring the patient that effective care will be provided. Specifically, an EMS responder should: Provide his or her name upon arrival so the patient feels at ease.

Are close-ended questions required in EMS?

In a few exceptions, close-ended questions are necessary. EMS personnel are often required to use radios, cellphones, and other electronic communication devices. Why is communication important in emergency situations?

COMMUNICATION is critical in emergency situations. It is the primary way EMS personnel obtain patient information, interact with medical facilities, and contact other emergency agencies. A communication breakdown between emergency personnel, patients, and families can be dire: improper treatment, misdiagnosis, and potentially death.

Why do emergency responders need mobile data terminals?

Mobile data terminals also enhance communication by tracking calls from the same address, thereby allowing the emergency responder to get information in advance. This information is valuable if, for instance, the patient is known to be violent or to have repeated health concerns, such as asthma.
