Do I need a travel adapter in Tonga?

What most travellers need to know is that Tonga uses an electrical current is 240 volts 50 Hz and accepts Type I (i) plugs, so if your appliances don't fit the electrical outlets and/or require a different voltage or frequency, then you're going to need a travel adapter and maybe even a converter. Makes sense?

What type of plugs & sockets are in Tonga?

The power plugs and sockets in Tonga are of Type I. This is a three-pronged plug with one vertical prong and two slanting prongs. Some electrical appliances plugging into a Type I sock only have two slanting prongs. If you have visited any of the following countries, chances are that you already have a travel adapter that will work in Tonga.

Will a 220-240 volt power supply work in Tonga?

If you're using appliances from a country that also uses 220-240 V, then they will work in Tonga as long as they have a Type I output or you have a travel adapter. More on that later.

Does Tonga use a 50 Hz outlet?

Tonga uses a 50 Hz outlet. Therefore, it is not recommended to use a 60 Hz appliance, even if the voltage of your appliance is compatible with Tonga. Using the wrong frequency (which is what Hz is) can cause appliances to stop functioning properly. Again, check your appliance label. Some appliances work on both 50 and 60 Hz.

What voltage should I use in Tonga?

More on that later. If coming from a country that uses 110/120 V, for example, then you should find that modern appliances, such as phones and laptops, are designed to use from 110 V to 240 V. Regardless, you should check the labels of all of the appliances that you intend to use in Tonga.

What is the electrical current in Tonga?

The electrical current in Tonga is 240 volts with 50 cycles per second. So the main information you will need to know for using your appliances in Tonga is that the electricity in Tonga runs on 240 V 50 Hz.

Since Tonga uses Type I outlets, you'll need a Type A/B to Type I adapter. Additionally, as the voltage in North America is different, you may also need a voltage converter for devices that ...
